It is the responsibility of each recipient to contact the Ed Troxel Endowment Board of Directors to initiate disbursement of funds.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Ed Troxel Endowment Scholarship is to promote the athletic, scholastic, and leadership values of Ed Troxel. Dedication, ambition, eagerness, vision, resourcefulness, love, and the ability to work for the benefit of others are but a few of the characteristics that reflect the nature of Ed Troxel and the recipients of this award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of the Ed Troxel Endowment Scholarship recipients will be based upon several factors, including athletic involvement at high school, leadership, service, scholastic achievement, personal statement and references. The scholarship may be awarded each academic year to one female and one male from Kennewick, Kamiakin and Southridge High Schools who will attend a post-secondary school, college or university. <u>Applications must be electronically submitted and received no later than March 31, 2023.</u>

Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection by April 15, 2023 and are required to attend the Ed Troxel Golf Tradition on Saturday May 6, 2023 where they will be introduced to endowment supporters. Upon verification of enrollment, awards will be issued directly to the designated college or university.

Each applicant will:

- 1. Be a member of a graduating class from Kennewick, Kamiakin or Southridge High Schools.
- 2. Have been involved in high school athletics.
- 3. Verify academic achievement by submitting a photocopy of transcripts for the last seven semesters.
- 4. Show involvement in the community and/or school demonstrating leadership qualities.
- 5. Include a personal statement. (See application for details)
- 6. Include a letter of recommendation from a coach.
- 7. Include a letter of recommendation from a responsible community member.
- 8. Submit a completed, online application packet.
- 9. Authorize the use and release of scholastic information contained in this application for scholarship information and/or news releases.
